The following equipment **MUST BE** carried for the duration of the ride around Maria Island.

Self-check	Required equipment	Scrutineer check
✓	<p>L100 or PFD50** life jacket The east coast of Maria Island is classified as Coastal Waters so an L100 is required. However, <u>for this event only</u> an L50 has been permitted by MAST. PFD must meet AS4785 standard. No inflatable PFDs, whether automatic or manually inflatable.</p>	✓ <i>MAST requirement</i>
	Fire extinguisher (0.75kg required for most skis)	<i>MAST requirement</i>
	Flares** : Mandatory: 2 orange, 2 red	<i>MAST requirement</i>
	Rear towline : securely stowed but readily accessible. (Club recommendation: preferably at least 10m long)	<i>MAST requirement</i>
	Front towline ###: long enough to be grabbed by another ski, but short enough not to be sucked into intake grate.	<i>Jetskitas requirement</i>
	At least 70 litres fuel , but more if ski requires it for expected distance + safety margin. Securely strapped to ski###.	<i>Jetskitas requirement</i>
	Hard copy of PWC licence + ski registration (or screenshots from MAST website)	<i>Jetskitas requirement</i>
	Hard copy of current insurance policy (or unedited screenshot/photo)	<i>Jetskitas requirement</i>
	Morning tea/snacks for the day + 1-2 litres of drinking water	<i>Jetskitas requirement</i>
	Sunscreen	<i>Jetskitas requirement</i>
	<p>Recommended:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gear for expected weather conditions: sun/UV protection, cold, wind. Consider hat/helmet, sunglasses/goggles, gloves, non-slip boots, long sleeves & pants, warm coat • Screenshot of payment of your registration fee • 2 parachute flares** • VHF marine radio** • Personal Locator beacon (PLB)** 	
	<p>To be provided to rider on the day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ski sticker • Fluoro vest in team colour 	

Feel free to ask for advice before arriving at the briefing if information on securing fuel, length of front towline is required, or you have any other queries.

** Normally, these items are mandatory for the Coastal Water part of this ride. However, we have been given special permission by MAST for this event only for these to be recommended, but not mandatory.
